ECONOMIC INVESTMENT

In 2019, ABIR members contributed over \$830 million to Bermuda economy:

- \$624 million in payroll to Bermudian-based employees
- More than \$131 million on construction, real estate, housing, and office space
- Nearly \$68 million on legal, accounting and actuarial, IT, temporary services and other consulting services
- More than \$20 million on hotels, airfare, restaurants, taxis and catering

WORKFORCE **DEVELOPMENT**

- ABIR members employed 1,576 full-time staff in Bermuda, 1,137 of which were Bermudians. spouses of Bermudians, or permanent residence certificate holders
- ABIR members offered nearly 60 internships to Bermudians
- Educational scholarships in Bermuda topped \$1.3 million
- Members continue to offer graduate training programs, tuition reimbursement and leadership training





CHARITABLE CONTRIBUTIONS

- ABIR member companies contributed more than \$6 million to Bermuda charities in 2019
- Between 2005-2019, ABIR members provided over \$143 million to Bermuda charities
- ABIR members gave \$3.1 million in the first six months of 2020 during the global pandemic
